

Kirk Session-Elders Service

The Kirk Session previously agreed that, upon appointment, elders would serve a term of three years, with the opportunity to continue for a further term thereafter. As this new approach is still in its early stages, there has not yet been an occasion to implement this process properly.

In keeping with these earlier decisions, it is proposed that, over the coming months, Andrew McKellan and Mark Malcolm meet with all elders. These meetings, expected to last no longer than 45 minutes, would provide an opportunity for encouragement and reflection, set within a spirit of seeking God together and building one another up. This would also allow elders to consider their calling to serve for another term.

It was also agreed that the congregation should be invited to recommend names of individuals who may be considered for addition to the Kirk Session. Any such recommendations would require the approval of both the Kirk Session and the minister before proceeding to either ordination or formal nomination. It is suggested that we give the congregation the opportunity to do this in June.
